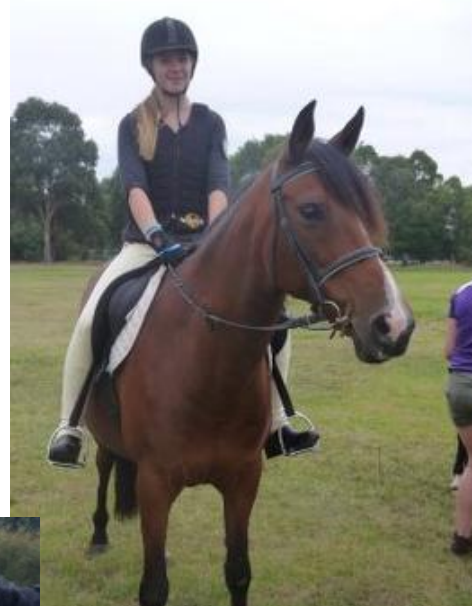

Grade 3 – Ride at 2.45pm (Christie, Alex)

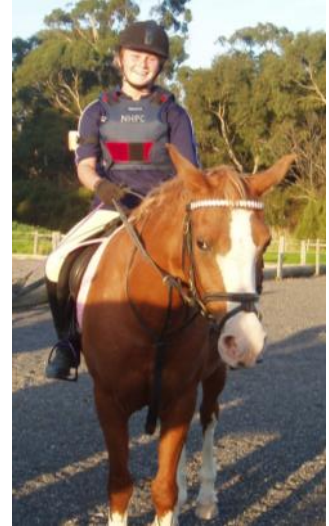
Grade Pre 5 and 5 jump judge

Urgent Notice: Potential Danger of Horse Hair
