This article is from July 1985.

In 1984 and 1985 the NHPC was heavily involved in negotiations to keep their grounds. According to this article the club achieved this wish. Thus 1986 was to be 'The Year of the Rebuild'

The Pony Club held leaseholds over

Fulton Road/Orchard Grove (20 acres for agistment) , Vermont St/Blackburn Rd (6 acres for agistment)

Vermont St/Mahoneys Rd (12 acres) This was the pony club grounds and also used for agistment

Mock Street (6 acres agistment) and Stevens Rd/Gaval Crt (5 acres agistment)

Improvement plans included construction of Cross Country, enclosed riding area, tree planting. Many things that needed to be done to improve the grounds WAS completed by members of the club

It would be very frustrating to work so hard to improve things for the community then to have to continue to fight to keep the land and facilities. As I read through the paperwork and newspaper articles I continually admire the efforts of these people and all members of the club and community to save something that they truly believe in.
