## Karlee Craine Goes to Equitana

Karlee was invited by the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd, who had a display at Equitana, to perform at the event to show the versatility of the Arabian horse. The idea behind this was to show the many abilities of the Arabian horse. Kissy (First Kiss) had a very successful career as a halter horse being awarded, among many other titles, as Victorian Champion on two occasions. Kissy was then bred, proving that she can be used as a brood mare. Unfortunately her colt foal died not long after birth. Kissy was then broken in and following this came to Boralea and became a Pony Club mount. Karlee and Kissy have competed successfully in many disciplines and have had great fun in joining in the games events. This all went to prove that the Arabian is a very versatile horse. Karlee did a riding display in Nunawading Pony Club uniform and we had many questions asked about Nunawading Pony Club. During the afternoon a film crew from Japan asked if they could interview Karlee and ask her questions regarding Kissy. Their interest came about because Kissy has a unique pedigree. She is the ONLY Arabian horse in Australia, and we believe the World, that has a pedigree like hers. Her Grandfather on her Dam's side (Ralvon Pilgram) was awarded International Champion and her Grandfather on her Sire's side (Simeon Shai) was awarded Triple Crown World Champion. This aroused the interest of the film crew and they interviewed Karlee for quite some time about Kissy and showed great interest in the Nunawading Pony Club. Karlee (in full Nuna uniform) answered all their questions. They advised me that this interview would be shown (probably cut) throughout Asia, Europe, America and Australia. They will advise me when this interview will go to air.
