

We started out the day being rushed into Dressage as the team before us scratched, so with only a few minutes to prepare, we put our best effort in, Lauren, Sophie and myself all received 28 penalty points and Abbey received 22 we were all fairly happy with these results due to the very little time we had to warm up.

Next we had Show Jumping, we each had a clear round and only I had a time penalty. We were all happy with Show Jumping and very proud of our ponies.

After Show Jumping we had a few hours to rest and get ready for Cross Country, Mornington pony Club has an amazing XC course and everyone was super excited (and nervous) to ride it. Lauren, Sophie and Abbey each did a very good job in XC and were very proud of themselves.

When the results were put up we had come 9th out of 29 teams soon to discover there was a judging error in Sophie's XC score, well done Sophie for challenging the result. When Sophie's score was corrected we were bumped up to equal 7th place out of 29 teams! We were all thrilled with this score and very happy with everyone's effort.
