Please see Linda on rally days as she will be able to help you with obtaining the club uniform. She will have the 'uniform shop' open between 9 and 11 on these days. HI,

Well firstly hello to all and thank you for trusting me with the role of DC. I'm not going to pretend that I know all the ins and outs of the role. I will be very much learning as I go and am very thankful that I have Steph's ongoing support for any questions I can't find the answer to myself. So I'm sure it will all work out.

I think I know most members, but not all of you. So let me introduce myself a little. I'm a mother of two, Emily & Luke, and they are both members at Nunawading.

I also ride myself, I have a horse, Sam, a 9 year old Trakhener Sport Horse who is both my joy and personal challenge. I've been riding since I got my first horse when I was 15. That was a few years ago now, so I've racked up a bit of experience. I never attended pony club myself (back then I just went trail riding all around Vermont and even over to Drummies Bridge reserve or out toward the Dandenongs along Dandenong Creek.) Over the past 20 odd (cough, cough) years I've been a member of 4 different HRCV clubs and also an EA member.
